## Maori Party opens the door to Maori seats for Vision New Zealand

“Their message seems to be a **vote for the Māori Party is a vote for Labour**” said Hannah Tamaki Leader of Vision NZ Party in response to the Māori Party President declaring his strong preference to work with the Labour Party

“You would not be wrong to ask if Mr Wilson recently suffered severe concussion that resulted memory loss of 2004 Foreshore and Seabed, that ultimately lead to the birth of the Māori Party.”

Hannah Tamaki said Labour have not served Māori well, and said if the Māori Party Leadership have a strong leaning towards Labour, then they are nothing but a carbon-copy of Labour’s Māori Caucus who have achieved absolutely zilch.

“Well Our Membership have spoken, and we have listened, and as so far there is no Party contesting this election that represent genuine Māori aspirations, until Now....”

Vision New Zealand intends to run candidates in the Māori Seats, with a clear strategy to deliver back to Māori voters, a party that won’t sell out to either Labour or National before or after election day.

“An announcement on which seats we have selected will be made in due course, but as my husband keeps saying to me, Tamaki for Tamaki has a certain ring to it.” Said Hannah Tamaki.
